San Diego Foundation Scholarship

The deadline to apply for the Common Scholarship Application with the San Diego Foundation is quickly approaching!

The Common Scholarship Application provides students access to more than 140 scholarship opportunities with awards ranging from \$1,000 to more than \$5,000.

Scholarships are open to:

- Students with financial need (includes middleincome families)
- Graduating high school seniors
- Students attending four-year universities, community colleges or career/technical schools

The deadline to complete the application is **Wednesday, March 6, 2024, at 2 pm** (PST).

COLLEGE DECISION DEADLINE UPDATES

You may have heard of or are dealing with the many changes, technical glitches and roadblocks that have been associated with the updates to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Because of the FAFSA delays, many colleges are adjusting their enrollment deadlines. Typically (unless you applied Early Decision), colleges require an enrollment decision and deposit by May 1st. The National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC) just released a list of colleges that have changed their deadlines beyond May 1st. The list will be updated daily as well. Please be sure to read the fine print on any college acceptances, and know your enrollment and financial aid deadlines.
