INTERESTED IN VETERINARY SCIENCE?

The Junior Veterinary Scribe Certificate is offered through Washington State University College of Veterinary Medicine. This program is intended for students ages 16 and 17 who want to enter the workforce after high school with a skill set to assist them in finding entry-level work in the veterinary field as a scribe, veterinary receptionist, or veterinary assistant. The program includes 10 online modules.

The programs introduce students to basic anatomy and medical terminology associated with the physical exam, diagnostics and pharmacology. In addition, students learn how to navigate a medical record.

Students will have the skills necessary to transcribe the veterinary visit, communicate effectively with clients and colleagues and support members of the veterinary health care team.
