HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR CCHS GPA

Your GPA is calculated by dividing the total amount of grade points earned by the total amount of credit hours attempted. First convert every semester letter grade into the number equivalent, giving one extra point for Honors and AP courses when a grade of C or better is earned. Add up your total points and divide by the total number of classes to find your GPA. Pluses and minuses do not affect your GPA.
