2016-2017 Profile

CATHEDRAL CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL (CCHS) is a Catholic faith community that serves students by preparing them for college and lifelong learning. CCHS also provides the character formation necessary for students to become responsible global citizens. CCHS was founded in 2005 (formally University of San Diego High School, founded in 1957) and enrolls approximately 1650 students from the greater San Diego County and Tijuana, Mexico in grades 9-12. CCHS is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the Western Catholic Education Association (WCEA). CCHS holds membership with the National Catholic Educational Association (NCEA) and College Board.

MISSION

Cathedral Catholic High School is an innovative academic community of lifelong learners grounded in the Catholic faith that prepares our graduates to live God's call and build the Kingdom.

THE CURRICULUM

A typical schedule consists of 35 units (7 classes) per semester.

A minimum of 270 units is required for graduation. 5 units = 1 semester; 10 units = 1 year. Graduation requirements include: 40 units (4 years) Religious Studies; 40 units (4 years) English; 20 units (2 years) Language other than English; 30 units (3 years) Mathematics; 30 units (3 years) Science; 30 units (3 years) Social Science; 10 units (1 year) Visual and Performing Arts; 35 units (2.5 years) elective credit (may include core courses); 20 credits (2 years) Physical Education/Health and/or Sports Affiliation; 5 units (.5 years) Speech Communication.

Advanced Placement and Honors courses have prerequisites that students must meet in order to be enrolled. There is no limit on the number of AP/Honors courses a student may attempt each year. In 2015-2016, 476 students sat for 848 exams. Of the 848 exams taken, 595 exams had scores of 3, 4 or 5. In addition, 83 students were recognized as AP Scholars.

TEST SCORES

For the class of 2016, 270 students took the SAT during the 2014-2015 and 2015-2016 school years. Mean test scores are as follows:

GRADING AND RANKING

Cathedral Catholic High School assigns letter grades using a 4.0 system. Letter grades are assigned as follows: A = 90-100%; B = 80-89%; C = 70-79%; D = 60-69%. Advanced Placement, Honors and Dual Enrollment courses are weighted by one point. All credit classes are included in computing grade point averages. Grades are recorded on transcripts. Grade point averages are computed in January and June. CCHS has a rigorous college preparatory program; therefore, a cumulative ranking system based on GPA does not fairly represent a student's relative achievement. For this reason, CCHS does not rank.
